She would plan meals for the week and then send her mom the list to pick up from the store. She even had a small business, Bitez of Komfort by Kai, that consisted of baked goods and comfort dishes such as Shrimp Alfredo with homemade alfredo sauce.





Kai fought a lifelong, 22 year battle with Sickle Cell Anemia and on April 5, 2024, her days on the battlefield as a true warrior were over. She left many memories, gifts, and recipes with us to remember her by, therefore, we believe this effort is befitting.
